- People with pulmonary hypertension (PH) often do not look sick
- PH is high blood pressure in the lungs; it is a rare, incurable, and life-threatening disease
- People of any age or ethnic background can have PH
- PH symptoms include breathlessness, dizziness, and fatigue
- PH can make even the simplest tasks of daily living difficult
- PH is not contagious; you cannot “get it” from someone else
